This year, ***A Taste of Italia***, pairs Italian wines Soave and Pinot Grigio with an Antipasti course. Primo is filled with Spaghetti alla Carbonara, Liguine with Puttanesca Sauce and Chicken Picatta topped off with Sangiovese and Barbera wines. Secondo turns to a classic Chianti wine and Gnocchi with Vodka Sauce, Cavatappi with Pepperoni and Lasagna. Dolce, the final course, is Tiramisu, Pistachio Ice Cream, Zabaglione with Berries and ends with a sparkling Prosecco. Traditional Chianti also will be served at each table. And what would an evening in Italy be without live music featuring Frank Sinatra songs? A live auction of wonderful wine baskets ends the evening. Proceeds will benefit the Denver Firefighters Museum and will be used to expand our fire safety and prevention programming. The event is Saturday, September 20, 2008 from 6 to 10 p.m. Tickets are \$25.00 per person or \$45.00 per couple. Reservations are requested.
